I was fine with the Chief signing as the head of the department and the Manager's designee for police matters. I hereby confirm that the agreement is approved for form and legal sufficiency (and can place my stamp on the agreement if you would like). I view this as within the discretion of the City Manager/Chief of Police as part of running the department and improving an already existing gun range. As long as the Manager/Procurement Director/Chief would have the authority to procure the item, it is permissible. Here, it is well within the procurement authority discussed in section 2-650 of the City Code, and is also an exempt item under 2-678(25) (exempting "[g]oods and services provided by other government entities). Accordingly, it can be approved administratively.
