You have represented that you are replacing an existing wood deck on your property and that the replacement deck will be in the same location as the one you are removing. I have reviewed this matter and issue this opinion pursuant to Sec. 2-201(e)(1) and (8) of the City Code, authorizing the City Attorney's Office to issue opinions and interpretations on behalf of the City and pursuant to Sec. 2-702 of the Zoning Code giving the City Attorney the final authority with regard to legal issues involving interpretation and implementation of the Zoning Code. Based on the facts of this case, the proposed replacement deck improves an existing legal non-conformity (by removing a wood deck which is rotted and has become a safety hazard and replacing it with a new and safer deck) and continues along the same legally non-conforming setback that has already been established for the deck (the size of which is already present along the legally non-conforming setback). This opinion is consistent with previous interpretations of Article 6, including CAO 2014-30. It is therefore concluded that the request should be allowed without need for a variance (assuming all other applicable provisions of the Zoning Code are satisfied).
