

RE: Legal Opinion Regarding Permit Fee

Date: November 4, 2020

You have brought to my attention that while editing the Fee Schedule in order to attach it to the resolution amending the fee schedule that was adopted by the City Commission on September 22nd, you inadvertently deleted the "new construction and additions" fee, as shown in Ex. A attached. Consequently, the relevant section that was attached to the City Commission resolution did not contain that line, as shown in Ex. B attached. As mentioned, you have explained that this was an inadvertent deletion. Consequently, the Commission was not advised that the fee was removed as that was not the intent.

Section 2-252(e)(9) grants the City Attorney the authority to make corrections to ordinances, resolutions, and the Code where appropriate to address Scriver's errors. Accordingly, I am instructing the City Clerk to correct the Scriver's error in the fee schedule that was attached to Resolution No. 2020-228, by inserting the language that was inadvertently deleted.
